


Redevelopment of the Former Grange School, Warmley

Site History







1921

In the past, the site was used for coal mining and has still, to date, some residual mine shafts on site.





1999

The Grange School and Sports College was an 11-18 mixed, community secondary school and sixth form college established in the 1970s on the site. A central building was accessed via Tower Road North and featured various sports facilities to the north and south of the school building.







2024

The Grange School closed in August 2016 and was partly destroyed in an arson attack in 2021. Since then, the whole school building and artificial grass pitch to the west were demolished by the council.

The only remaining operational building on site is the Majestic Gymnastics centre which underwent refurbishment and extension in 2023.
